KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

COUNTY OF HARRIS

WHEREAS, by instrument dated October 31, 1940, recorded in Volume 1190, Page 108, of the Deed Records of Harris County, Texas, Arthur L. Brown, et al, imposed certain restrictions and easements upon that part of the August Bering tract in the Chase Park subdivision in Harris County, Texas, lying between Westheimer Road and Northway Drive (formerly Park Drive), which said land was partitioned into four tracts containing 53.63 acres each, including certain lateral and north and south roads, and reference is here made to said instrument and the record thereof for all purposes; and,

WHEREAS, certain other restrictions and easements may have been imposed on said land by other instruments not herein specifically mentioned; and,

WHEREAS, it is contemplated that that part of abovementioned tract lying north of the north line of San Felipe Road will be developed as a residential subdivision, and it is desired for our mutual benefit and advantage that certain of the restrictions and easements imposed by the instrument first abovementioned, and any other instruments not herein specifically mentioned, be changed and/or released and abandoned, in so far, but only in so far, as same applies to that part of abovementioned tract lying north of the north line of San Felipe Road;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned, being all of the parties holding any valid or equitable title in and to the property set forth in abovementioned instrument executed by Arthur L. Brown, et al, recorded in Volume 1190, Page 108, of the Deed Records of Harris County, Texas, for and in consideration of One and No/100 Dollar (\$1.00) each to the other in hand paid and for our mutual benefit and advantage, do hereby release, relinquish and abandon those certain restrictions and easements, if any, but only in so far, as same apply to and are imposed upon that part of said tract lying north of the north line of San Felipe Road, and not in any wise affecting same which apply to and are imposed upon that part of said tract lying south of the south line of San Felipe Road, as follows:

1. All restrictions and easements of every kind and character which may have been imposed upon said tracts, or any part thereof, by any and all other instruments not herein specifically mentioned are hereby released, relinquished and abandoned; provided, however, that those restrictions and easements set forth in abovementioned instrument recorded in Volume 1190, Page 108, of the Deed Records of Harris County, Texas, shall be in nowise affected except as hereinafter set forth.

2. Only those restrictions and easements imposed by said instrument executed by Arthur L. Brown, et al, recorded in Volume 1190, Page 108, of the said Deed Records, as are specifically set out below, are hereby released, relinquished and abandoned:

a. Restrictive covenant No. 4 which reads: "No residence shall be erected on any part of said property closer than 60 feet to the front property line of the lot upon which same is situated and no closer than 15 feet to any side line except that outbuildings may be placed within 5 feet of sidelines if the same are located 150 feet or more from the front line of the lot upon which the same are situated" is hereby released, relinquished and abandoned.

b. Restrictive covenant No. 7 which reads: "Every lot or tract shall be subject to an easement 5 feet wide on the ground and 10 feet wide at a point 30 feet from the ground upward on each side and rear line for the construction and maintenance of public utilities and for drainage sewers or ditches" is hereby released, relinquished and abandoned.

It being our intention and we do hereby affirm that said restrictions and easements set forth in said instrument executed by Arthur L. Brown, et al, recorded in Volume 1190, Page 108, of said Deed Records, or in any other instrument not herein

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specifically mentioned, shall be in nowise affected by the herein instrument, in so far as it may apply to all that portion of said tracts lying south of the south line of San Felipe Road and that all of said restrictions and easements shall remain in full force and effect; that said restrictions and easements set forth in said instrument executed by Arthur L. Brown, et al., recorded in Volume 1190, Page 108, of said Deed Records, shall be in nowise affected in so far as said restrictions and easements apply to that portion of said tracts lying north of the north line of San Felipe Road, EXCEPT AS SAME ARE HEREBY SPECIFICALLY RELEASED, RELINQUISHED AND ABANDONED, and that same shall otherwise remain in full force and effect; all in accordance with the terms of the instruments setting forth same.

The property affected by this instrument is briefly described as follows, to-wit:

All that part of those tracts of land set forth in abovementioned instrument recorded in Volume 1190, Page 108, of the Deed Records of Harris County, Texas, lying between the north line of San Felipe Road and the south line of Woodway Drive (formerly Park Drive).

This instrument may be executed in any number of counterparts, no one of which needs to be executed by all parties, and shall be binding upon all those parties who have executed such a counterpart, and their heirs, successors and legal representatives, with the same force and effect as if all such parties had signed the same document; provided, however, that this instrument shall not be effective until all parties have so executed one of said counterparts.
